
## glaciers

The native Tlingit call the sound "white thunder," when chunks of ice tear from a tidewater glacier and crash into the waters below. We call it spectacular — an experience of a lifetime that engages all of your senses. Every Princess voyage offers at least one glacier viewing experience, and many offer two scenic days. On several voyages, you can spend a magical day gliding through Glacier Bay National Park. But why stop at that? Princess also invites you to hike across glaciers, race on a dogsled and soar above it all while flightseeing.



## wildlife

# glacier bay national park

Princess® is an authorized concessioner of Glacier Bay National Park.

Only accessible by boat or by plane, this 3.3 million-acre UNESCO World Heritage Site will show you unending natural beauty in a single day. Draw close to tidewater glaciers like the iconic Margerie Glacier as park rangers (who scale the ship to join you on board) share compelling details. When a glacier calves, you'll understand why the native Tlingit describe it as "white thunder." Among all the wildlife you can expect to see, look for humpback whales surfacing in the bay and mountain goats clambering over steep cliffs.



## endicott arm & dawes glacier

You won't be able to stop looking as you sail through the waterway of Endicott Arm. Waterfalls flow easily in the granite cliffs that rise from the fjord, where chunks of ice float by. Just ahead, emerging into view between a narrow passageway, is the grand finale — Dawes Glacier, which stands more than 600 feet tall and a mile wide.



## hubbard glacier

North America's largest tidewater glacier is a remarkable sight to behold. It measures an astonishing 76 miles long and 1,200 feet deep, and its rapid flow means that ice chunks frequently calve from the edge in a true spectacle. This region is teeming with wildlife, so keep your eyes open and your camera ready.



## college fjord

College Fjord offers the world's largest collection of tidewater glaciers, including the famed Harvard Glacier. Discovered in 1899 during the Harriman Expedition, professors on the excursion named glaciers after elite colleges, such as Harvard, Vassar and Yale. See for yourself why this is hailed as one of the world's most scenic destinations.
