With stops to soak in luxurious mineral-rich pools, this easy to drive circuit takes in the highlights of the Canadian Rockies in Alberta and BC in an easy 9 day loop starting and ending in Calgary. The longest inland free ferry ride in Canada nestled in the Kootenays is an additional bonus. Start Calgary / End Calgary or Edmonton.



BRITISH COLUMBIA AND ALBERTA THE CLASSIC WESTERN CIRCUIT (16 Days Recommended)

Explore the beauty of Western Canada from the Pacific coast and Vancouver Island, to the wine country of British Columbia, to the Rocky Mountains and the classic gems of Banff, Lake Louise and Jasper. This tour gives you a taste of British Columbia and Alberta's most spectacular and best-known highlights. Start Vancouver / End Vancouver



HIDDEN GEMS - THE NATIONAL PARKS OF ALBERTA AND SASKATCHEWAN (21 Days Recommended)

Drive through beautiful wilderness, vast open skies of the Canadian prairies and the diversity of Alberta and Saskatchewan's national, provincial and regional parks. From the badlands, the grasslands, the boreal forest to the glaciers of the Rocky Mountains - this drive includes it all. Enjoy air so fresh you can taste it, glorious star-lit skies with the milky way shining through. Start Calgary / End Calgary or Edmonton



THE YUKON EXPLORER (12 Days Recommended)

RVing in the Yukon is far more than a standard road trip and more of driving long stretches beneath dramatic mountain ranges, sprawling valleys and along wild rivers. Moose, caribou, mountain sheep, black bears, grizzlies and wood bison, are all commonly seen. Historic sites, art galleries, museums and several Yukon First Nations Indigenous cultural centres, offer reasons to stop, learn, explore and stock up on supplies. Start Whitehorse / End Whitehorse



ALBERTA HIGHLIGHTS (12 Days Recommended)

There is no better time than now to explore the gems of Alberta including the southern Alberta highlight of Waterton Lakes National Park. From the Stettler Steam Train experience near Red Deer, the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village, the bison at Elk Island and Dinosaur Provincial Park, this is a road trip to the less crowded attractions, all visited with short drive days. Start Calgary / End Calgary or Edmonton.



GREAT NORTHERN CIRCLE (14 Days Recommended)

A stunning RV drive through the untamed wilderness of BC's north. See a collection of dinosaur footprints in Hudson's Hope, overnight in Dawson Creek - Mile 0 of the Alaska Highway, and stop at the famous sign post forest in Watson Lake, Yukon, with more than 67,900 license plates, road shields and homemade signs mounted here. Drive through the Kispixox Valley, home to more than 50 Indigenous totem poles, visit 'Ksan Historical Village in Hazelton and pass the Bear Glacier - one of the few roadside blue glaciers in the world. Start/End Various.
