



Day 2 Depart the USA - San Juan, Puerto Rico

The whole island of Culebra is about 10 square miles and is divided into six barrios (Spanish for districts). Day 4 Esperanza Bay, Vieques Island, Puerto Rico

The quaint coastal town of Esperanza has a lovely waterfront with gorgeous beaches and a bustling strip of restaurants, bars, and guesthouses. One can walk along the boulevard and visit the various establishments for a glimpse into the local culture and activities on offer. Locals enjoy spending the afternoon at Sun Bay, the main urban beach located in the town's eastern outskirts. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 5 Virgin Gorda, Gorda Sound,

British Virgin Islands

Virgin Gorda is the third-largest and second-most populous of the British Virgin Islands. Columbus' lieutenants named the island Virgen Gorda – or 'the pregnant virgin', as upon approaching the island from the north or the east, the outline of a pregnant woman lying on her back is visible on the horizon. Somehow uncrowded, Gorda Sound itself has recently blossomed into a busy place surrounded with resorts and vacation villas. Virgin Gorda is a beautiful island; an ideal jumping off point for an in-depth discovery of the Virgin Islands. **Meals: B, L, D**.

Day 6 Gustavia, Saint Barthélemy

Named for Sweden's King Gustav III, Gustavia is the capital and main seaport of the island of Saint Barthélemy, also known as St. Barth. The island is said to have been discovered by Christopher Columbus back in 1493, who named it after his brother Bartolomeo. The indigenous residents of the island were called the Taino Indians. Despite claims of discovery and ownership by various European settlements, the Taino Indians did not welcome foreigners until the 18th century, when French mariners successfully settled on the island. The buccaneers, also known as pirates, actually helped boost the economy by trading gold for local products. The island traces influence from Great Britain as well as Sweden but was eventually returned to French rule in the late 19th century. **Meals: B, L, D**

Day 7 Marigot Bay, Saint Martin

Marigot is a lovely town and the administrative centre of French Saint Martin. Both French and Caribbean culture can be seen throughout the island, creating that unique blend of French Caribbean. Some of the most spectacular sights include the castle of Fort Louis overlooking the town and reminding locals and visitors alike of its significant past. The open-air market is open every day for those seeking to discover the island's local vibe and flavours. Artisans here sell anything from fresh fruits and spices to artwork and even rum. The market is a delight to the senses, and while you are there, don't forget to try Mauby, a local beverage flavoured with bark which tastes like root beer. **Meals: B, L, D**

Jost Van Dyke is the smallest of all four main islands comprising the British Virgin Islands, approximately eight square kilometres. Known as 'The Last Virgin Island', White Bay Beach on Jost Van Dyke is made up of rather rocky scenery combined with colourful local culture. The bay is by far one of the best beaches to relax on, with plenty of room for visitors to lay down and enjoy splendid Caribbean views. Today, you will enjoy a barbeque on shore together with your fellow travellers. **Meals: B, L, D**

Should you choose not to purchase our TPP, the following per person cancellation charges will be assessed for all tours and optional excursion costs:


