Day 1: Saturday September 5, 2026 • Depart

Our adventure starts today as we depart the USA on our scheduled flight to Athens, Greece.

Day 2: Sunday, September 6, 2026 • Athens

Upon arrival in Athens, we meet our local tour manager and transfer to our hotel in the city center. After time to rest and refresh from the journey, we take a gentle orientation walk through the historic Plaka district, the charming old neighborhood at the foot of the Acropolis, where narrow lanes, neoclassical houses, and inviting cafes offer a pleasant introduction to the city. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to relax, enjoy a coffee, or settle into the new surroundings before we gather this evening for a welcome dinner at a traditional Greek restaurant. **D**

Day 3: Monday, September 7, 2026 • Athens

After breakfast, we set out to explore the ancient heart of the city with a guided visit to the Acropolis, where the Parthenon, the Propylaea, the Erechtheion, and the Temple of Athena Nike rise above Athens as enduring symbols of classical Greece. Following our time on the sacred hill, we continue to the nearby Acropolis Museum, where beautifully displayed artifacts and sculptures bring the story of the Acropolis and ancient Athenian life into vivid focus. This afternoon, enjoy free time to explore the shops and cafes of Plaka or Monastiraki before gathering this evening for dinner at a restaurant overlooking the illuminated Acropolis. **B/D**

Day 4: Tuesday, September 8, 2026 • Mykonos

This morning we fly to Mykonos, the quintessential Greek island of whitewashed houses, blue domes, and seaside

charm. After checking in, we enjoy a guided walking tour through Mykonos Town, visiting Manto Mavrogenous Square, the iconic windmills, the picturesque waterfront of Little Venice, and the unique Church of Panagia Paraportiani. The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure to relax, shop, or enjoy a cafe by the harbor. **B**

Day 5: Wednesday, September 9, 2026 • Mykonos

After a relaxed breakfast, we take part in a hands-on Greek cooking class, learning to prepare traditional island dishes using fresh local ingredients before enjoying the meal together. The afternoon is free to relax at the hotel, stroll the winding lanes of Mykonos Town, or spend time at a nearby beach. **B/L**

Day 6: Thursday, September 10, 2026 • Mykonos

Today we explore the quieter side of Mykonos as we travel inland to the traditional village of Ano Mera, where we visit the historic Panagia Tourliani Monastery, known for its ornate iconostasis and religious treasures. We continue to Mykonos Vioma Organic Farm, an authentic vineyard and farm where we enjoy a tasting of local products in a peaceful rural setting (if available). The rest of the day is yours to spend at your leisure. **B**

Day 7: Friday, September 11, 2026 • Santorini

Today we board the ferry to Santorini, one of the most breathtaking islands in the Aegean, where whitewashed villages cling dramatically to volcanic cliffs. Upon arrival, we transfer to our hotel and have time to settle in before heading out. We visit the Santorini Wine Museum, an underground museum that tells the story of the island's unique volcanic

wine tradition, followed by a tasting of local varieties. We return to the hotel for a free evening to relax, explore nearby shops, or dine at a local restaurant. **B**

Day 8: Saturday, September 12, 2026 • Santorini

After breakfast, we set out to explore Santorini, visiting scenic viewpoints and traditional villages before arriving in Oia, the island's most picturesque town, known for its whitewashed houses, blue domes, and stunning caldera views. Enjoy time to stroll the lanes, browse local boutiques, or relax at a cafe overlooking the sea. The afternoon is at leisure to further soak in the island's unique atmosphere. **B**

Day 9: Sunday, September 13, 2026 • Santorini

After breakfast, spend the day at your leisure exploring the island. **B**

Day 10: Monday, September 14, 2026 • Athens

This morning, we transfer to the airport for our short flight back to Athens. Upon arrival, the rest of the day is free to enjoy some shopping or explore more of the city at your own pace. In the evening, we gather for a farewell dinner to celebrate the highlights of our journey through Greece's history, flavors, and island landscapes. **B/D**

Day 11: Tuesday, September 15, 2026 • Return to U.S.

Transfer to the airport for your return flight to the USA, bringing home wonderful memories of Greece's history, flavors, and island landscapes. **B**

Invoice will be sent out prior to final payment. Passengers may add after this date subject to air and land availability. In the event a surcharge is imposed after Ed-Ventures has received a final payment, Ed-Ventures will send an additional invoice for the surcharge amount. Early registration is encouraged.

Currency:

Currency exchange rates fluctuate constantly. In the event of a significant drop in the value of the dollar, we reserve the right to add a currency surcharge to the price of the tour.

Refund/Cancellation Policy:

All cancellations must be in writing. The date of postmark will determine the amount of refund due. Refunds are based on the number of days prior to departure date. From the time of deposit to 120 days before departure a \$100 administrative fee plus any airfare penalties will be assessed. From 119-46 days, a \$500 cancellation penalty plus lost airfare deposits and any unrecoverable deposits to ground suppliers will be assessed. Airline tickets once purchased are nonrefundable. Anyone canceling less than 45 days prior to departure will receive **no refund**.

Purchase of health, baggage, and trip cancellation/interruption insurance is strongly recommended.

Terms and Conditions

We reserve the right to cancel this trip due to lack of subscription. In the event of cancellation of the trip in its entirety, a full refund of all deposits will be made to passengers enrolled at the time of cancellation.
